Curriculum

Readers Workshop-

This week students will hear the story A Harbor Seal Pup Grows Up and practice the skill of wondering to understand a nonfiction book. We will explore features of a nonfiction book such as the glossary and index. Students will learn the vocabulary words scoot, tip, release and survive.

Writers Workshop-

The sight words us and up will be introduced this week. Students will hear the nonfiction story <u>Chefs</u> and acquire a list of

things they want to know about chefs. We will then extend that and discuss other teachers and staff in the building that students want to learn more about what they do. We will come up with a list of questions as a class and interview that person if available. Students will continue their nonfiction writing as they write what they learned about chefs and the person we choose to interview.

Math - This week students will continue to find the sum of addi-

tion equations by using various strategies used in class. Ask your child about what strategy they've been using to help them find the answer and have them model it for you!

Theme— This week we will be learning about St. Patrick's Day and doing various activities such as making shamrock puzzles, doing a graphing activity with lucky charms and a shamrock long vowels activity.
