Curriculum

Readers Workshop-

This week students will hear the nonfiction story <u>A Tiger Cub</u> <u>Grows Up.</u> Students will practice the skill of wondering to help them understand the text. We will learn the vocabulary words wild, tame, creep and pounce.

Writers Workshop-

The sight words eat and she will be introduced. We will continue our work from last week and hopefully interview another staff member about their job. Students will then write what they

learned and extend their writing to write about jobs they know about. We will also brainstorm a list of questions to ask other students in the class and students will get to interview a classmate, followed by a writing activity.

Math– This week we will explore the 3D shapes cube, cylinder and cone. Students will have opportunities to use Dreambox inside the classroom and during computer time.

Theme— This week

we will start a unit of study on spring which will transition into a study about weather, seasons, and planting. We will talk about what happens in springtime and make kites. We will read the book It Looked Like Spilt Milk and do an activity that follows.
