Curriculum

Readers Workshop— This week students will hear the story <u>A</u> - <u>My Name is Alice</u> which is a book with lots of alliteration. After hearing the story, students will each get assigned a letter and we will make another class book similar to the framework of <u>A</u>-My Name is Alice.

Writers Workshop— This week we will continue with opinion writing as students hear the story <u>I Love School</u>. Students will write about their favorite thing we've done at school so far.

Students will then write an opinion about how we could celebrate the end of the year together. We will share our opinions and agree or disagree with each other respectfully.

Math- During math this week we will continue to work with subtraction and various strategies to get the answer such as using manipulatives, using our fingers or drawing a picture. We will also continue to work with equal groups which will be extended into talking

about making shapes equal by cutting them in half.

In math this week we will also learn about our 3D shapes as students have to find objects that match.

Theme— This week we will be learning about fish! We will label the parts of a fish and learn about it's fins and what they do. We will compare a goldfish and a guppie. Lastly, we will practice using describing words to make a list about fish
