## Curriculum

#### Readers Workshop-

This week we will spend time reading the book <u>I'm Not</u> Scared... I'm Prepared! Which is a book about the ALICE model. AL-ICE stands for alert, lockdown, inform, counter, and evacuate. These strategies would be used in the case of a dangerous person inside (or outside) the building. We will slowly go over this text and talk about different situations and what our response would be. This information will be taught in a kid-friendly way.

This will be followed by various lockdown drills, so we can practice what we've learned from the book.

### Writers Workshop-

This week we will start unit 6 which is about opinion writing. Students will hear the poem Alligators are Unfriendly and we will discuss the authors opinion and the reasons for his opinion. We will then make a list of animals we think would make good pets and animals we think wouldn't and write our opinion. We

will share our opinions and agree or disagree with each other respectfully.

Math – This week we will continue to work with groups and make them equal by either adding or subtracting. We will also continue our work with teen numbers and show the 10 in every teen number various ways.

Theme— This week we will be learning about turtles! We will learn about the parts of a turtle and will compare a box turtle verses a painted turtle. We will watch a live video of turtles hatching!

# Mrs. McCarthy's Corner

In literacy centers and during reading instruction we are currently learning

- Blends, which are a group of two or three constants that makes a distinct sound, such as pr, bl, sp, and st
- Diagraphs, which are two letters that work together to make the same sound, such as sh, th, and ch
  - Inflectional endings such as -ing and -ed
    - Long vowels

All of these things are going to help your child become a better reader and writer! Please draw your child's attention to these things as they arise.
