Readers Workshop-

Writers Workshop-

Partners of 10—Card Game

There are many different card games you can play to help your child deepen their understanding of numbers. In the game partners of 10, you will need to remove the K, Q, J and 10 and also have a common understanding that the Ace stands for 1. Start by placing 10 cards face up (5 on top, 5 on bottom). Your child should shout out partners of 10 they see. For example, they might say 6 and 4, 8 and 2! You would then remove those cards they say and replace them with new ones. Your child would continue to shout out partners of 10 until they can't make any more. This is a great game to help your child build a quick recognition of partners of 10.
