## Curriculum

Readers Workshop-
We are in Unit 3 in our Making Meaning unit. Unit 3 focuses on the skill of retelling. Students will hear the story Maisy's Pool by Lucy Cousins and practice turning and talking with a partner, sharing what their partner told them and retelling different parts of the story.
Writers WorkshopDuring Writer's Workshop this week we will talk about various topics students can write about such as family, holidays, toys, pets, etc. Students will then practice the steps of thinking,
drawing their picture, counting the words and writing the words. Students will learn how to edit their work this week by re-reading their writing, making sure it makes sense, and checking for a capital letter at the beginning and an ending mark at the end.

Math- This week we will finish up Unit 2 and take our unit test. As a review, unit 2 focused on building children's understanding of numbers 1 through 10 by using 5 groups. By using 5 as a number block,
children were able to recognize the numbers 6 through 10 easily.

## Theme-

We will start our month long unit about Holiday's Around the World. This week we will share traditions that each child does during the holiday season. We will make a surprise picture out of a 100 chart, practice one to one correspondence by putting ornaments on a Christmas tree and do an activity with wants verses needs.
